A BILL

To amend the Public Works and Economic Development Act of 1965 to include projects to facilitate the relocation, to the United States, of a source of employment outside the United States as eligible under certain grant programs, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the “Made in America Jobs
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PUBLIC WORKS AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT**2 **ACT OF 1965 ASSISTANCE ELIGIBILITY.**

3 (a) GRANTS FOR PUBLIC WORKS AND ECONOMIC
4 DEVELOPMENT.—Section 201(a) of the Public Works and
5 Economic Development Act of 1965 (42 U.S.C. 3141(a))
6 is amended—

7 (1) in paragraph (1) by striking “and” at the
8 end;

9 (2) in paragraph (2) by striking the period at
10 the end and inserting a semicolon; and

11 (3) by adding at the end the following:

12 “(3) projects to facilitate the relocation, to the
13 United States, of a source of employment located
14 outside the United States; and

15 “(4) projects to facilitate the growth of the
16 manufacturing sector or the customer service sec-
17 tor.”.

18 (b) BASE CLOSINGS AND REALIGNMENTS.—Section
19 202 of the Public Works and Economic Development Act
20 of 1965 (42 U.S.C. 3142) is amended by inserting “, in-
21 cluding a project to facilitate the relocation, to the United
22 States, of a source of employment located outside the
23 United States or to facilitate the growth of the manufac-
24 turing sector or the customer service sector,” after “or
25 realignment”.

1 (c) GRANTS FOR PLANNING AND GRANTS FOR AD-
2 MINISTRATIVE EXPENSES.—Section 203(a) of the Public
3 Works and Economic Development Act of 1965 (42
4 U.S.C. 3143(a)) is amended by inserting after “economic
5 development planning” the following: “, including plan-
6 ning with respect to projects to facilitate the relocation
7 to the United States, of a source of employment located
8 outside the United States or to facilitate the growth of
9 the manufacturing sector or the customer service sector.”.

10 (d) GRANTS FOR TRAINING, RESEARCH, AND TECH-
11 NICAL ASSISTANCE.—Section 207(a)(2) of the Public
12 Works and Economic Development Act of 1965 (42
13 U.S.C. 3147(a)(2)) is amended—

14 (1) by striking subparagraph (H);
15 (2) by redesignating subparagraph (I) as sub-
16 paragraph (K); and
17 (3) by inserting after subparagraph (G) the fol-
18 lowing:

19 “(H) assessment, marketing, and establish-
20 ment of business clusters;

21 “(I) activities to facilitate the relocation, to
22 the United States, of a source of employment
23 located outside the United States;

1 “(J) activities to facilitate the growth of
2 the manufacturing sector or the customer serv-
3 ice sector; and”.

4 (e) GRANTS FOR ECONOMIC ADJUSTMENT.—Section
5 209(a) of the Public Works and Economic Development
6 Act of 1965 (42 U.S.C. 3149(a)) is amended by inserting
7 after “loan fund),” the following: “projects to facilitate the
8 relocation, to the United States, of a source of employment
9 located outside the United States, projects to facilitate the
10 growth of the manufacturing sector or the customer serv-
11 ice sector.”.
